The Lighting of the lamp was followed with NSS Song by NSS Volunteers. Smt Susama Dash, Principal, Womens College addressed the student volunteer and shared his four years of experience on NSS Camp. Dr. D. K Mohanty, Chief guest, addressed the students volunteers on their responsibilities for the community, Dr Archana Pattanaik, the Guest of Honour put little more light on the importance of NSS for students and the role of NSS volunteers for creating awareness among students and community service. Dr Reba Patro also shared her views and inspired the volunteers. Dr Sarita MIshra, Programme Officer NSS, UNIT-II introduced all the guests and briefly presented the objectives of Special Camp activity details to be undertaken during the camp. The day one dt 23.12.18 of the special camp was started with regular activity of the camp followed with lighting of the camp. Then student volunteers arrived at the camp at 6.00 a.m and then engaged with village cleaning. Then the morning prayer and exercise was done by the student volunteers. The orientation class on NSS was taken by Dr Archana Pattanaik, EX -PO. NSS Unit-I and CH Kirti, Ex-Volunteer. After the orientation class volunteers had their breakfast. Then all the volunteers were sent in a group to village households to interact with the villagers a for a rapport building.
